<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Answers from the Principal (FYI - In the future questions are to be submitted prior to the meeting to the Principal) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● For future meetings, this would be where questions would be addressed (questions sent in before meetings) ● TTFM - last year 50-50 results about Zoom versus in-person interviews. Could there be an option moving forward to do one in person and one via Zoom? Could there be an option to run both ways? This is targeted more for K-4. MCMM: This year far less commentary on this question ● Can parents be notified about Touchstone awards and not just Bronze/Silver/Gold awards? ● MY/SY assembly parents not invited - parents not notified about awards ● Newsletter - whole school - is it able to be read in different languages - MCMM to check with the provider ● Parents letting students out at roundabouts - not safe - need to keep it prominent with parents - lobby to the council - a reminder to parents in the newsletter - staff presence. VELM/MCMM: often written about in the College newsletter and via Compass alerts. Staff presence occurs randomly. ● When will these meetings occur? MCMM: generally Week 6 -7 of each term
